Thomas golf course and the most delightful spa this side of paradise. The property's recently completed \$90-million renovation and expansion makes this a truly unique California destination.

The award-winning 31,000-square-foot luxury spa has 28 treatment rooms. Here you will find a knowledgeable staff to guide you through the list of highly original treatments. Try the very refreshing Pixie Body Scrub where the massage therapist extracts the juice of a half-dozen Ojai Pixie tangerines and incorporates this clixir into the scrub. After 50 minutes of bliss, your skin is super-hydrated and glowing! Throughout the spa, women are milling about comfortably in their robes...sampling the nice selection of herbal teas, reading, or just dozing in the comfortable lounge area. In this welcoming atmosphere you'll find massage rooms with fireplaces, whirlpools, steam rooms, saunas and sunbathing loggias for men and women.

There are many activities to keep you busy throughout your stay. Visit Spa Ojai's charming Artist's Cottage and Apothecary located under a centuries-old oak tree. Choose from a wide array of classes in mixed media, from painting on glass to silverpoint drawing and silk scarf painting—all taught by local artists. The Apothecary is also a perfect setting for creating your own personal scent of essential oils that bears your name—a lovely souvenir to take home.

There are golf and tennis lessons available, and personal training sessions at Spa Ojai's well-equipped gym. The daily schedule of complimentary mind/body classes, including t'ai chi, yoga, qi gong and meditation, fill up fast with eager participants, as do the very enjoyable power walks and nature hikes!

On the property are four wonderful restau-rants, and their team of culinary experts all work closely with the local farmer's markets to offer up the most enticing organic fare.
